Log Books Submission

As previously said, log books for the following 3 events must be submitted prior to the competition: Gravity Vehicle, Mission Possible, and Rubber Band Catapult.

How to submit log books:

If the log book is handwritten, please take pictures of each page, scan, and email as a pdf to <u>bayareaeso@gmail.com</u>. There are numerous scanning apps you can download on your phone so please make sure the scan is legible and clear.
Email the log book as a pdf with the subject line "Team X Log Book - Event Name" (ex. Team 10 Log Book - Gravity Vehicle). Nothing less, nothing more.
If you have a digital version of the log book, you can email the link/share the Google drive link in the email or attach it as a pdf. If it's a Google doc, please still send the link via email rather than just sharing it from the Google doc so that we will not miss it. Please use same format for the subject line.

Make sure of the following:

- Only one submission per event per team. Coordinate which student is sending it. If one student has half the log book and the other student has the other half, make sure to combine them into one pdf before sending it to us.
- Please number the pages.
- Use the full name of the event in the subject line. Do NOT abbreviate as GV, RBC, or MP.
- Each log book per event must go in a separate email. Do NOT submit all 3 of your team's log books in the same email.
- Log books must be in pdf format unless they are in Google drive.
- If these rules are not met, teams may be asked to resubmit.

All log books are due Wednesday, May 20 by 11:00 PM PST.

Please adhere to this time as late submissions may not get reviewed by judges.

Log books may be submitted from the student, parent, or coach's email as long as it has the appropriate subject line.
